Judging

All works are judged by local artists. One entry per student is allowed and must be an original piece produced by the artist. Work that has been produced with commercial kits, prefabricated forms or other commercial methods is not allowed. Each entry must have been completed within the current school year.

Categories

Primary (K – 2)
Intermediate (3 – 5)
Middle School (6 – 8)
Lower High School (9 – 10)
Upper High School (11 - 12)

Prizes

(Per Age Category)
1st Place \$100
2nd Place \$ 75
3rd Place \$ 50

In addition, one high school student will receive the PSO Mark of Excellence Award, a \$500 cash prize for outstanding creativity and technique.

Return of Entries

Entries must remain in the Youth Art Gallery until Sunday, May 16th at 3:00 p.m. All works must be picked up between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 16th. Mayfest is not responsible for the return or storing of any entries left after this time.

Deadline

All entries must be delivered to the Performing Arts Center LaFortune Studio, located at 3rd and Cincinnati on **Thursday, May 6th, between 4:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.** Enter the PAC through the doors located to the west of the main entrance doors. There will be a freight elevator to the second floor. **DO NOT ENTER THROUGH THE TICKET OFFICE DOORS.**

Identification

THREE Youth Art Gallery Identification Forms must be completed. **One, which should NOT INCLUDE the student's address or phone number, must be attached to the front of the art piece for display purposes, the two other fully completed forms must be with the artwork at delivery.** The art piece must be ready to hang or show (i.e., frame, dry mount, mat, etc.)
